OAK RIDGE, TN --The Oak Ridge High School Class of 1967 has announced that they have exceeded the \$10,000 milestone in their effort to raise money for landscaping at the newly-renovated Oak Ridge High School. Since February, the group has raised a total of \$10,530 dollars for the project.

"It is super that we went over \$10,000," said fundraiser Chairperson Karen Edwards. ""We want to thank everyone who so generously donated money to the landscaping fund. This project can really help create a green environment for our children at the school."

"Yet, while it has been great to see the contributions so far, we still have a ways to go to completely landscape the High School. "

Landscaping funds for the Oak Ridge High School were eliminated as part of a school system cost-savings initiative. When members of the Class of 1967 heard about the landscaping shortfall earlier this year, they decided to start a fundraiser to try and help.

The Oak Ridge High School is currently undergoing an extensive 50-million-dollar renovation.

The landscaping fundraiser will run through this coming Saturday, June 16, 2007.

The organizers are currently meeting with school officials to determine the best use for the landscaping money that has been raised so far. The number one priority is to buy 15 new Oak Trees for the school''s front ellipse. Next in priority is the purchase of 3 flowering trees and shrubbery for the school''s flag plaza followed by the purchase of benches and landscaping for the outside amphitheater.
